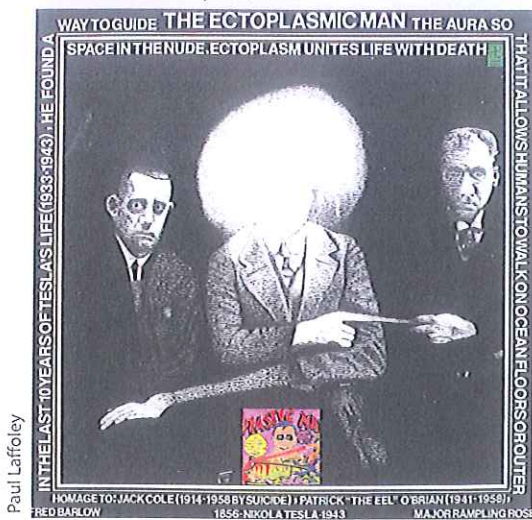


THE MUSEUM OF EVERYTHING AT MONA, TASMANIA

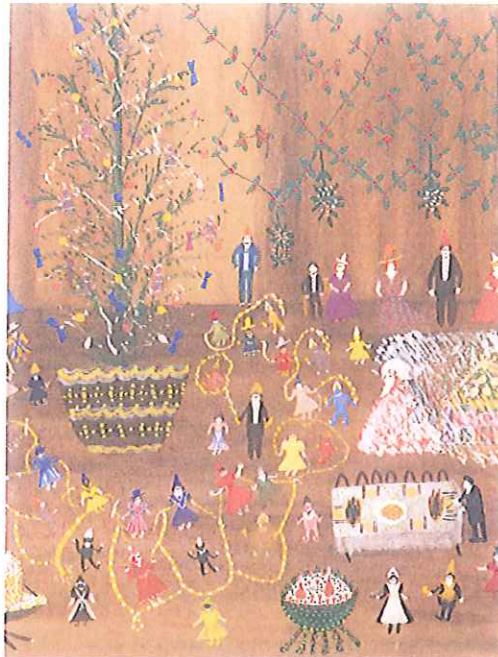
