three very special artists: Manuel Griebler,

All three artists are incredibly passionate about making art and work every day; their art is at the centre of their lives.

Currently the youngest of the Gugging Artists, Griebler's dense and colourful works are juxtaposed with those of the more established Strobl, whose small-format drawings on newsprint transport the viewer to landscapes of haunting

Opening this weekend at the <u>Gallery of Everything</u>, *Full of Days* is a dialogue between Andy Holden and the late Hermione Burton, a local artist he discovered in his home town of Bedford. In his signature practice, Holden uses a combination of in depth biographical research and visual make believe

to reimagine the artist's life in profound detail.

The exhibition opens with two short films by Holden which discuss the work and provide context and commentary.

In 2017 Holden came across a curious gro up of eclectic paintings in a charity shop in his hometown of Bedford. The bold signature declared the author's name: *Hermione*.

Accompanying the artworks were framed photographs of the artist and a self-published autobiography, *Hermione Burton: A Journey Through the Paintings*, a thin booklet which described the major events of the artist's life, her creative evolution and her ongoing struggles with ill health.



This special exhibition at <u>GAIA Museum</u> presents work by Hugh Lynn, who was


in Smith Falls, Ontario, Canada.






